

CDTA COVID-19 AGREEMENT

Cranleigh Dance and Theatre Arts are committed to mitigating the risks regarding the transmission of COVID-19. The measures we have put in place will hopefully enable us to stay open even if someone has a positive COVID-19 test result. With social distancing we can prevent the spread and by introducing 'bubbles' we can reduce the number of children coming into contact with each other. Please work with us because if we break these measures we will potentially be at risk of closure, whereas if we can prove we have maintained social distancing we should be in a safer position. Please therefore read this agreement with your children and abide by the rules.

CRANLEIGH DANCE AND THEATRE ARTS WILL:

- Put social distancing measures in place and only break these if there is a first aid or personal emergency.
- ➤ Place children in 'bubbles' to mitigate the risk of transmission.
- > Implement and commit to cleaning procedures at the start of classes and in between classes. This will include anything that students and teachers have touched.
- > Ensure students clean/sanitise their hands before class and after using the toilet.
- Remind students to use tissues and "catch it, bin it, kill it"
- ➤ Inform you if there is a positive case of COVID-19 at CDTA and follow guidance from Test and Trace and the Public Health organisation as what procedures to follow.
- ➤ Follow the guidance and advice from the Government about local lockdowns or closure.
- Keep you informed of any changes.

WE ASK THAT YOU:

- Maintain social distancing in class and also if children are waiting in between classes.
- ➤ Try not to put yourself in high risk situations such as visiting a place in local lockdown or coming into contact with someone who may have a suspected case of COVID-19.
- ➤ Do not come to class if you or your child are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19; high temperature, persistent cough, loss of taste or smell. If you or your child have symptoms you will need to get tested. If you receive a positive result then you need to stay at home for 10 days and other members of the household for 14 days. If your test is negative then your child may return to class.
- Let us know immediately if you or anyone in your household test positive for COVID-19 .
- ➤ Please arrive to class on time and make sure you and your child remains at a social distance of 2m from other families.
- Please pick up your child on time and remember to social distance from other households.
- Please where a face covering if you have to come on site or if you can't maintain a 2m social distance.

FEES AND REFUNDS:

- We are unable to refund fees for children who are absent from class due to illness or self-isolating.
- We are unable to refund fees if we are told to close by the Public Health Authority or the LA due to an outbreak.
- ➤ If the local area is put into lockdown then we will consult with parents about fees and the financial situation to ensure that the dance school remains financially sustainable whilst not disadvantaging families.
